



Cypress Point (1.0 mi.)

Island Trail (0.6 mi.)











Trail Descriptions

American Holly Trail

The trail follows a gentle grade making it suitable for all levels of hiking and biking fitness. It joins with the Loblolly Trail to form a loop.

Lobiolly Trail

The Loblolly Trail loops around Trap Pond linking the Park Office, Campground, and Baldcypress Nature Center. Nature enthusiasts may witness abundant wildlife, wildflowers, and bald cypress trees. The trail popular among birding enthusiasts features an elevated boardwalk that traverses a fresh water wetland.

This loop trail meanders through mixed forest and along the pond's edge where abundant bald cypress trees flourish in the park's wetlands. This trail is ideal for all levels of hiking fitness.

Island Trail

This short loop trail meanders along the pond's edge over a packed earth surface. The trail connects with the American Holly and Loblolly Trails and is suitable for all levels of hiking fitness.
